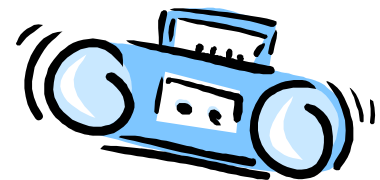

deadlines on the banquet hall, meals, d.j. and park are quickly approaching.

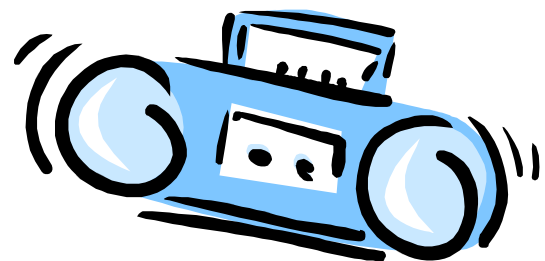
Q: I heard talk about a cruise. Is it still on?
