Talent Show Eligibility & Rules

- 1.) The show is open to AMATEUR entertainers of all ages. (Performers whose talent is a principle source of income are not permitted to enter.)
- 2.) Contestants must be a Coweta resident, work in Coweta, or attend Coweta Public Schools
- 3.) Soloists and groups of up to five are eligible.
- 4.) Each act is limited to a maximum of 5 minutes. This will include set up, performance, & breakdown.
- 5.) All contestants must arrive and be ready to perform at 1:15pm on Saturday, Sept 19th. Contestants arriving late may be disqualified.
- 6.) Contestants will be judged based on talent, originality, dress/costume/character, audience interaction and overall appeal.
- 7.) Contestants must not have engaged in any activity which, by community standards, could be characterized dishonest, immoral, indecent, or in bad taste. No previous criminal convictions.
